Meetinghouse Church is seeking an Audio/Visual Technician to set up, operate, and maintain audio/visual equipment for Sunday services, both in-person and live-streamed. The ideal candidate will have worship technology experience, strong communication and teamwork skills.

Key Responsibilities

- Set-Up and Tear-Down of audio equipment each Sunday
- Sound check prior to each service
- Mix FOH and livestream mix for one of our two Sunday Services
- Monitor audio throughout the service to address any issues that arise promptly
- Provide technical support for any A/V related issues in one of our two Sunday Services
- Collaboration - work closely with the worship team, including musicians, pastors, staff, and other A/V technicians.
- Maintenance - regularly inspect and maintain audio equipment to ensure it is in good working condition.

Essential Skills and Experience

- Proven experience as an Audio Technician, preferably in a worship or live performance setting
- Proficiency in operating digital soundboards – specifically Midas/Behringer consoles
- Strong understanding of audio equipment
- Ability to mix a variety of instruments & musical genres
- Excellent ear for sound quality and attention to detail
- Ability to troubleshoot and resolve technical issues quickly
- Strong communication & teamwork skills
- Ability/willingness to work with students and encourage their growth as an A/V technician.
- Ability to work under pressure and adapt to changing circumstances
